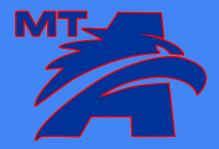

MTA Staffing Request #1: RtI Teacher

- Current Position & Program
- Oversees & Manages Rtl Referral Process for Math, Literacy, & Executive Function
- Provides Direct Support to 55 Students (Currently) in Organization & Executive Function



MTA Request #2: School Counselor/Director

- Additional Counselor Necessary to Spread Post-Secondary Planning & 504 Case Management Load
- Direct Oversight of Counseling Services, 504 Management, & Post-Secondary Planning Needed through Leadership Role
- + Additional Counseling Days Needed for All Counselors



MTA Request #3: Substance Use & Crisis Social Worker/Counselor

- Provide additional social work intervention and support for high needs students
- Ongoing, established need to provide support to individual students in substance use disorders and dependency management
- Provide district leadership in educating students about dependency and addiction, as well as policy guidance
